**Humanities Concentration Requirements**

36 credit hours, distributed as follows:

**“Core” courses - 18 credit hours**

- (1) Select **two** courses from the following list:
  - HUM 2210      Studies in Culture: The Classical Through Medieval Periods
  - HUM 2230      European Humanities: Renaissance to 20th Century
  - HUM 2250      Studies in Culture: The Twentieth Century
  - HUM 2273      Eastern and Western Culture from Antiquity to 1400
  - AMS 2270      20th-Century American Culture
  
- (2) Select **one** course from the following list:
  - FIL 1002      Introduction to Film Studies
  - HUM 2522      Introduction to the Cultural Study of Popular Music
  
- (3) **HUM 3804 Introduction to Cultural Studies**  
Students must pass this course with a B- or better in order to register for the Pro-seminar.
  
- (4) **Pro-seminar/Senior Seminar two-semester senior-year sequence - 6 credit hours**
  - HUM 4331    Humanities Pro-Seminar
  - HUM 4931    Seminar in Humanities
  
- (5) **Plus an additional 18 credit hours of upper-level HCS electives** – any course offered by the Humanities and Cultural Studies Department including those with (FIL and AMS)

**Requirements for the Minor in Humanities:**

1. 18 credit hours of Humanities courses (HUM prefix).
  2. No more than eight credit hours may be 1000, or 2000 level courses. At least 10 credits must be upper level.
